

Curriculum Vitae Prof. Dr. Martin Heine

Martin Heine studied biology at the Friedrich Schiller university Jena and University of Rostock Rostock (both Germany) and at the university of Glasgow (Scotland, Great Britain). He obtained his Ph.D. in zoology at the university of Göttingen (2002).

He was awarded a post-doctoral fellowship from the German Research Foundation *DFG* to work in the group of Daniel Choquet at the Université de Bordeaux (2002–2007).

From 2009-2018 he lead the research group *Molecular Physiology* at the Leibniz Institute for Neurobiology in Magdeburg (Germany).

In 2018 Martin Heine was appointed with a professorship for Functional Neurobiology at the Johannes Gutenberg University in Mainz. His research interests focus on the function of molecular dynamics of ion channels and adhesion molecules in synaptic plasticity and neuronal network activity.
